### 1. WIN - We are Life Bearers.

- God's great desire is for all to come to salvation.
- We can't just be church within its four walls.
- If a church does not win souls it tends to disappear due to lack of fruit.
- Winning souls is a privilege: **Daniel 12:3**
- · Winning souls requires being brave.
- Forgiveness is essential to winning souls: John 5:20
- Winning is a necessity and has a reward: 1 Corinthians 9:16-17

### **Characteristics of an Evangelist:**

### A. Needs to have a mentor: Acts 21:8

- Needs to have a team
- · Needs to preach the gospel for love.

### B. Be a testimony of submission:

- Needs to serve: Acts 6:3-5
- The vision demands effort, goals, and submission to authority.
- Christ is the centre of us to win souls: John 3:16

### C. Be the Spearhead (cutting edge): Acts 8:14

- No excuses.
- No arguments.
- First in everything. 1 Corinthians 6:16

### D. The evangelist is where there is a need: Acts 8:26

- One must be where the Lord needs one.
- Must be light everywhere.
- · Has to be sensitive to the Holy Spirit.
- E. Must have a Spiritual Rhema.

F. Must love the Scriptures: Acts 8:35

G. Takes advantage of opportunities: Acts 8:40

### What does compassion mean?

Must have compassion for people: 2 Timothy 2:10

### CONSOLIDATION

- Must have a pastor's heart to care for souls and retain the fruit.
- Must understand the value of a soul and become a caregiver: Revelation 20:11-15
- · Consolidation begins when the person prays the sinner's prayer and decides to follow Christ.
- It is necessary to make the phone call within 48 hours.

### A. Objectives of Life Class:

- Inner Healing

- Vision.

### B. Characteristics of a consolidator:

- Compassionate
- Full of the Holy Spirit.
- Intercessor.
- · Full of Faith.
- True carer.

### C. Objectives of Evangelism:

- Pray for people's needs.
- Take them to pray the Sinner's Prayer.
- Ask for Prayer Request.
- · Achieve visiting the new person.
- · Open a cell group.
- · Locate the new person in a cell.
- Locate the new person in the church.

### **Pastor Wes Richards:**

### I would like more information about the Prayer Tent. What results were obtained from this strategy

### **Prayer Tent:**

- Distributed the team of 12 in 4 groups.
- Evangelism takes place every Saturday.
- 40 people won.
- 27 people located in cell groups.
- 7 people sent to the Life Class.
- Average of 420 people won in the month.
- An average of 87% soul retention.
- Strategy 1 X 3, 1 week is evangelized, 3 weeks is consolidated.

### Do you go out to the same place every Saturday?

- No, every Saturday we go to different places.
- Places include: Hospitals, colleges, universities, etc.



# DISCIPLE & SEND

DAY 2



So Moses' father-in-law said to him, "The thing that you do is not good. Exodus 18:17

- The ministry that endures is that which forms leaders.
- You must choose people of character, of good attitude and who want to be challenged through goals.
- It is important to first teach and then choose.

### How should I raise effective leadership? Numbers 11:16-17

- As a disciple is so is their leader. The spirit that is in the leader, that same spirit will be in the disciple.
- Select
- · Involve.
- Impart.
- Share.

### Why is it important to train new leaders? 2 Kings 6:1

### 1. If I form new leaders, the results will be multiplied.

- It is important to have a good work environment. (Meeting of 12)
- · Your team's level of motivation is the level at which you've challenged them

### 2. Through them the right spirit is transmitted.

You have to impart the right spirit and enter a new level.

### 3. Why train good leaders?

- · Your twelve should be a support to doing the work and not an impediment.
- It's useless if we don't form and send leaders.

### Ps. Knolly Shadrache:

### What does 'involve them so that you can choose them as part of your team' entail?

- The Vision must be developed in every cell.
- Disciples must do the work with their leader.

### Ps. Knolly Shadrache:

### Is your wife doing the same dynamic as you are?

We're both doing it.

### Ps. Giovanni Berhitu:

### Is it possible that people from other churches attend Destiny Training?

- There's no problem, you can help a lot of people.
- The important thing is to make it clear to them that they remain in their church and we will only be supporting them.

### What is usually done with non-attendance in Destiny Training?

- We follow-up absences through leaders.
- Teachers should also be on the lookout for class attendance.

### How do you set clear goals in teams of 12?

- Not all twelve are on the same level to set a single goal.
- A goal cannot be turned into a demotivation.
- Identify the measure of faith of each disciple and thus be able to establish achievable goals. It is not a goal for each disciple, but a maximum of two goals in general for two levels.

### What to do with people who are in a cell for a long time and then leave?

- It is important to keep in touch with those who have these situations.
- It is necessary to have people linked to the church.

# CELL GROUPS

DAY 3



Now let me sing to my Well-beloved a song of my Beloved regarding His vineyard: My Well-beloved has a vineyard On a very fruitful hill. He dug it up and cleared out its stones, and planted it with the choicest vine. He built a tower in its midst, and also made a winepress in it; So He expected it to bring forth good grapes, but it brought forth wild grapes. "And now, O inhabitants of Jerusalem and men of Judah, Judge, please... Isaiah 5: 1-5

- We are in times of acceleration and visitation.
- You can't go out into battle without a strategy, a plan, a roadmap, and a guide.
- Each of us has a responsibility for what God has given us.

### How can we make a cell fruitful?

- · Pray, believe and visualize that what God has given you will bear fruit.
- As pastors we are that leadership that will carry out God's purpose.
- The Vision G12 is that fertile hillside as a strategy to bear fruit.
- God designed us to be competent and fruitful leaders.

### **FUNDAMENTAL ASPECTS OF A CELL GROUP**

### 1. God takes the cell and fences it:

- He cares for and protects it so that it will grow according to God's purposes and this purpose will be fulfilled.
- A church grows when its cells are strong and cared for.

### 2. Clear it of Stones:

- It is necessary that people be cleansed in the cell group, that they have an encounter with Jesus.
- That arguments be removed in the cell, so that they can have the revelation of the cross.
- The leader must watch over every person in the cell.

### 3. Plant:

- May the cell that is planted bear the best fruit.
- The leader must sow love, understanding, friendship, advice, time.

### 4. Build a tower:

- This represents the supervision of cell groups.
- The leader and the pastors must be those watchmen who supervise what is done in the cell groups.
- · What is not seen in the sanctuary is because it is not being carried out in the cell group.
- · Supervision brings growth.

### 5. The Winepress:

- Work character into your twelve and leaders.
- · Bring out the best in our leaders so that they bear fruit.
- God expects fruit and multiplication from our cell groups.
- · We must train our leaders and disciples.
- The fruit that the Lord expects from our ministries and cells is the fruit that the Lord Jesus gave.
- God expects fruits of character, effort, dedication, commitment, seriousness, loyalty, and faithfulness.
- God will bestow as fruits, the gifts and fruit of the Holy Spirit.

### Ps. Charl Marais:

### Is a cell group more effectively fruitful when we first meet people before bringing them to church?

- The cell group is what gives you the most fruit.
- It is important to affirm people in their homes through the cells so that they attend church and the ministry grows.

### Ps. Wes Richards:

### How can we motivate people to lead cell groups?

- It is important to first work on their needs and then take them on to leadership.
- It is necessary to work in the hearts of the people.
- Work according to the character of each disciple.

### How can we lead people to serve Him and dedicate themselves to the service of God?

- It is God who puts that desire in people's hearts.
- You have to take them and challenge them if they really want to serve God.
- We are required to be intentional and form disciples.
- Whoever is passionate for God, God will give them fruit; God doesn't give fruit to a person who is not passionate.

### How can children be involved in Vision?

- · Children become involved in vision when we are attentive to them.
- · Having meetings with these ages is important to be able to take them to the vision.
